


THE STORY SO FAR ...


Good evening, everyone!





I was an elementary school teacher. I am happily retired now My daughter got a citizenship of Canada 5 years ago and she works as an accountant in New York.




Passerby were reading the labels

It's a piece of a cake to draw a model on a sketchbook size paper in 10 min. Drawing an actual size Peekaboo-kun in 10 min was a totally different story.












These Peekaboo-kun pleces will be painted and finished later, I I would love to exhibit them
